### **GATHR TO FIND PRIVACY POLICY**

#### 1. WELCOME

- 1.1 Gathr Tech Ltd ("Gathr", "we", "us" or "our") operates a platform, which it makes available through its website at www.gathrtofind.com (the "Website") which enables "Service Providers" to list and promote their services, and prospective users of such Service Providers' services ("Users") to view Service Providers' profiles and connect with them (the "Gathr Service").
- 1.2 This privacy policy sets out how we collect, store, transfer, share and use information that identifies or is associated with you (your "personal information") when you access and use our Website, use the Gathr Service or contact us about our products and services.
- 1.3 Please read this privacy policy carefully. If you have any questions about this privacy policy or how we use your personal information, please contact us using the contact details set out in paragraph 3 below.

### 2. Who is responsible for Your Personal Information

- 2.1 Gathr will be the controller of your personal information when you use the Website, contact us about the Gathr Service, contact us to list a Service Provider on the Gathr Service or leave a review about a Service Provider on the Gathr Service. This means that, in those circumstances, we determine and are responsible for how your personal information is used as set out in this privacy policy.
- 2.2 For some uses of personal information collected through the Gathr Service we act as a processor on behalf of the relevant Service Provider, meaning that the Service Provider, and not us, is a controller of that personal information and is responsible for how it is used. This applies where a Service Provider has featured your details on their profile on the Gathr Service, or if you are a User and contact a Service Provider through the Gathr Service. Please refer to the relevant Service Provider's privacy policy to understand how they will use your personal information.

#### 4. INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

- 4.1 When we collect your personal data, we will inform you if the information is mandatory or optional. If you do not provide any information which is marked as mandatory, we will not be able to respond to your request or, where applicable, provide you with access to the Gathr Service.
- 4.2 When you contact us about our products and services

When you contact us by email, chatbot, phone or through the "contact us" form on the Website, we will collect the following information:

### 5. COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

- 5.1 Cookies are pieces of code that we transfer to your computer's hard disk to store or collect information. We use cookies and similar technologies to collect certain personal information about how you access and use the Website.
- 5.2 For information about the cookies we use on the Website please see our cookie preference centre, which you can access when you initially browse the Website and at any time after that by clicking on the floating cookie widget on the Website.
- 5.3 Other than cookies that are required to operate the Website, we will only place cookies on your device or use these technologies to collect information with your consent. If you would like to withdraw your consent to non-essential cookies, you can do this by updating your cookie settings through the cookie widget on the Website.
- 5.4 Most browsers will also allow you to disable all cookies through your browser or mobile settings. These settings will typically be found in the "options" or "preferences" menu of your browser. Please note that if you choose to refuse cookies you may not be able to use the full functionality of the Website.

## 6. How long we keep your personal information

6.1 Unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law, we will only hold your personal information on our systems for the following periods:

Information about Service Providers that are sole traders (other than information about invoices and payments made by the Service Provider)	For as long as the Service Provider is listed on the Gathr Service.
Information about invoices and payments made by Service Providers that are sole traders.	For as long as the Service Provider is listed on the Gathr Service and for 7 years thereafter.
Support requests.	For up to 1 year from the date of receipt.
Reviews left by Users.	For as long as the relevant Service Provider is listed on the Gathr Service and for 6 months thereafter.
Information relating to Service Provider referrals.	For as long as necessary to review the referral, determine eligibility for and pay out a referral reward.
Device information, information about how you access and use the Website and approximate location.	This information is normally anonymised and aggregated on collection. The information collected for analytics may, however, be retained in identifiable form to enable historical analytics reporting and comparisons. This is generally kept for no longer than 14 months.

## 7. How we share your personal information

7.1 We may share the personal information we collect and use for our own purposes as follows:

The lawful basis we rely on for transferring this personal information is that the processing is necessary for our and the third party's legitimate interests, namely assessing and executing a potential transaction with us.
Law enforcement, regulators and other parties for legal reasons.	We may share your personal information with third parties as required by law or if we reasonably believe that such action is necessary to (i) comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement; (ii) detect and investigate illegal activities and breaches of agreements; and/or (iii) exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Gathr, its users or others.  These recipients will use your personal information in the performance of their regulatory or law enforcement role.	The lawful basis we rely on for sharing personal information with these recipients is that the processing is either necessary to comply with a legal obligation to which we are subject, or is necessary for our legitimate interests, namely enforcing our rights or complying with requests from regulatory authorities.

#### 8. International Transfers of your Personal Information

- 8.1 We may transfer personal information as described above in paragraph 7. This may mean that your personal information may be transferred to and stored in countries outside the country you are in where we and our third-party service providers have operations.
- 8.2 These international transfers of your personal information will be made pursuant to appropriate safeguards in accordance with applicable law:

United States	The transfer is subject to standard contractual clauses approved by the UK Information Commissioner for the transfer of personal information, or the transfers are to recipients certified under the UK Extension to the EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework.
Member States of the European Economic Area	Member States of the EEA are deemed to provide adequate protection for personal information under the UK Data Protection Act 2018.

- 8.3 We will take appropriate steps to ensure that your personal information is treated securely and in accordance with applicable law and this privacy policy regardless of where it is processed.
- 8.4 If you wish to enquire further about the safeguards we use, please contact us using the details set out at paragraph 3.

### 9. Your Privacy Rights

- 1.1 You have the following rights in respect of your personal information that we hold:
  - (a) **Right of access**. You have the right to obtain:
    - (i) confirmation of whether, and where, we are processing your personal information;
    - (ii) information about the categories of personal information we are processing, the purposes for which we process your personal information and information as to how we determine applicable retention periods;
    - (iii) information about the categories of recipients with whom we may share your personal information; and
    - (iv) a copy of the personal information we hold about you.
  - (b) **Right of portability**. You have the right, in certain circumstances, to receive a copy of the personal information you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format that supports re-use, or to request the transfer of your personal data to another person.

- (c) **Right to rectification**. You have the right to obtain rectification of any inaccurate or incomplete personal information we hold about you without undue delay.
- (d) Right to erasure. You have the right, in some circumstances, to require us to erase your personal information without undue delay if the continued processing of that personal information is not justified.
- (e) **Right to restriction**. You have the right, in some circumstances, to require us to limit the purposes for which we process your personal information if the continued processing of the personal information in this way is not justified, such as where the accuracy of the personal information is contested by you.
- 1.2 You also have the right to object to any processing based on our legitimate interests where there are grounds relating to your particular situation. There may be compelling reasons for continuing to process your personal information, and we will assess and inform you if that is the case.
- 1.3 If you wish to exercise one of these rights, please contact us using the contact details in paragraph 3.
- 1.4 If you reside in the UK, you have the right to make a complaint at any time to the Information Commissioner's Office ("ICO"), the UK regulator for data protection issues. You can make a complaint via the ICO's website (<a href="https://ico.org.uk/make-a-complaint/">https://ico.org.uk/make-a-complaint/</a>). This website also provides additional contact details for the ICO.

### 10. SECURITY

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal information against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, change or damage. All personal information we collect will be stored on our secure servers. Unfortunately, however, no security measures will always be completely effective. We will notify you in accordance with applicable laws if we become aware that your personal information has been compromised.

#### 11. OUR POLICY TOWARDS CHILDREN

The Website is not directed at persons under 18 and we do not knowingly collect personal information from or about children. If you become aware that we have collected information about your child without your consent, then please contact us using the contact details at paragraph 3 so that we can take steps to remove such information.

#### 12. CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

We may update this privacy policy from time to time and so you should review this page periodically. When we change this privacy policy, we will update the "last modified" date at the top of this privacy policy. Changes to this privacy policy are effective when they are posted on this page.
